Therefore, motorists or motorcyclists **found driving or riding without a driving license or an expired driver's license will be fined a maximum of RM300.**

The amount of this compound is the maximum rate, however, if the offender settles the compound within the stipulated period, the reduced fee is offered according to the schedule as follows:

VEHICLE TYPE	DURATION	COMPOUND RATE
Motorcycle	01-15 DAYS	RM 100
	16-30 DAYS	RM 150
	31-60 DAYS	RM 250
Vehicle	01-15 DAYS	RM 150
	16-30 DAYS	RM 200
	31-60 DAYS	RM 300

With this, any renewal of expired driving licenses at RTD counters can be done at all RTD offices or agencies appointed without paying the fine. The license renewal is subject to a driving license which expired not more than three (3) years.

RTD would like to advise the public not to be easily influenced and believe any messages via social media and WhatsApp applications that does not have a valid source. If in doubt the public is advised to refer directly to this department and do not participate in spreading misconceptions.
