RTD INTRODUCES VEHICLE OWNERSHIP CERTIFICATE (VOC) IN PLACE OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION CARD (RC)

The Road Transport Department (RTD) continues with the department's transformation by the introduction of the Vehicle Ownership Certificate (VOC) in place of the Vehicle Registration Card (RC) which will be implemented in stages by phases starting on the 1st of June, 2016.

The VOC identification is still a certificate of registration issued under the provisions of the 1987 Road Transport Act 1987, which contains details of the owner and the vehicle. However, in order to facilitate the transaction with RTD, the introduced VOC is no longer used as a document or instrument for managing renewals of the Motor Vehicle License (Road Tax), Change of Ownership or Amendment of Details. The VOC does not contain printed transaction record as contained in the RC while data review is conducted directly with the RTD's database system.

The implementation of the VOC will be done in stages as follows:

Phase	Vehicle Owners Involved
Phase 1 (1st June 2016)	The VOC will be issued to the owner registering new vehicles and a new owner for the process of transferring vehicle ownership.
Phase 2 (1 st September 2016)	The VOC will be issued to the owner who renews the road tax and the owner making amendments / corrections to the vehicle information.
Phase 3 (1st January 2017)	The VOC will be issued to owners who were present at the RTD (voluntarily) to replace the Vehicle Registration Card (RC)

The RTD targeted, by 1st January 2020, all owners of registered vehicles have implemented the replacement of vehicles RC to the VOC. With the implementation of the VOC, the service delivery system through online transactions will also be expanded and implemented more easily and quickly.
